## FOUR CARD POKER

In Four Card Poker, players receive five cards to make their best four card hand, and the dealer receives six cards to make their four card hand. The dealer always qualifies. The best four card hand wins and the player wins ties.

To play against the dealer, the player must make an Ante wager. After viewing their cards, to continue play against the dealer the player must make a Play wager. The Play wager must be at least equal to the Ante, and may be up to three times the Ante. The Ante and Play wagers pay even money.

**RANKING OF HANDS** Highest to lowest hands are as follows: Four-of-a-Kind, Straight Flush, Three-of-a-Kind, Flush, Straight, Two Pair, Pair and Highest Card.

**AUTOMATIC BONUS** The top three hands in the game, Four-of-a-Kind, Straight Flush and Three-of-a-Kind receive an Automatic Bonus payout on the Ante bet.

**ACES UP** Bet on the Aces Up spot and win when you are dealt a pair of Aces or better. The Aces Up bonus is always paid, regardless of the dealer's hand.

**MAXIMUM PAYOUT** The maximum aggregate payout per player during any one round, excluding the progressive jackpot payout is \$35,000.

Four Card Poker Progressive is an optional progressive bet. The bet considers the best hand possible among all the player's 4 cards in play.
